

Your role: Saint Angel National Park



Who are you?

You are a group of Saint Angel National Park representatives. The Park has a good reputation about the protection of flora and fauna and the main reason why people visit is to see all the endemic species that live there. Keeping the species safe in the park is important to maintain your reputation, to please environmental organisations, and to keep the flow of visitors, as they generate income for your park. From that income you pay for the upkeep of the National Park and the salaries of your employees.

What is your position?

Thus, you wish to protect the National Park and the species within, keeping in mind the employees and continuous expenses of the park. To have a media outburst and backlash would jeopardise income and sustainability of the National Park.

You should prepare your arguments to defend your position. You will have five minutes to present them during the trial.





Your role: Judge(s)



Who are you?

You are the group of judges who are presiding over this decision trial about the protection of animal species and human rights. As a judge, it is required to listen to all the parties and try to find a solution that can work for everyone. Further, you need to check that all parties are able to bring forward their arguments without interruption.

What is your position?

Your role is to invite each of the four parties to present their respective positions. At the end of the presentations, you should not make a judgement or come to conclusions. At this point, your job is to help to summarise the arguments and clarify the problems.

You should prepare questions to the parties. You will have ten minutes to ask your questions and listen to the answers.





Your role: Island inhabitants



Who are you?

You are the group of Isla inhabitant representatives who are dependent on fishing the species of fish that is under discussion. You were the ones filing a lawsuit against the National Park for prohibiting you to fish on your island.

What is your position?

You wish to preserve your way of living and one of the main sources of food. You stand for the human right to have a standard of living regarding to health and wellbeing.

You should prepare your arguments to defend your position. You will have five minutes to present them during the trial.





Your role: HUMANo



Who are you?

You are from the organisation HUMANo, an NGO fighting for human rights, and supporting cases where human rights might have been violated.

What is your position?

To properly help the island inhabitants, investigate human rights and how you can assist them. Research into good practices and former cases that can help you in your advocacy.

You should prepare your arguments to defend your position and support the island inhabitants with a stable basis of what human rights entail.





Your role: SavE



Who are you?

You are SavE, an NGO fighting to protect endangered species around the world. You regularly work with the Saint Angel National Park and protecting the local fauna and flora.

What is your position?

You want to support the National Park in preserving the local fauna and flora, in this case, the 3 fish species. Investigate how you can help with the preservation of endangered species. Research into good practices and former cases that can help you in your advocacy.

You should prepare your arguments to defend your position and support the National Park in their arguments.
